

Welcome to CPH LIVE 2020 - You are embarking on a SAS flight. Here is what you need to know

# **Pre-Flight Preperation**

Where to spawn. As a SAS flight flying in Europe, you should primarily spawn at a "B" gate

If no "B" gate is available use following priority

- 1. Any B gate
- 2. Any D gate
- 3. E20-E36
- 4. E82-E90
- 5. C28-C39 (ONLY for heavy airplanes & flights to outside of Europe incl. UK)



### **Special Aircraft & Destination assignments**

- CRJ900: Park at E82-E90 always
- **ATR72/Dash8**: Park at E76-E78
- Flights to U.K, Croatia and Russia should park at D1-D4 or E20-E36 Always!
- A330/A340/A350: use heavy "C" stands or "B10"

Handling agent: SAS ground Handling (GSX file to be downloaded here)



# ATC clearance checklist

Make sure you have all items taken care of when receiving ATC clearance

- ✓ You are requesting ATC clearance not more than <u>15 minutes</u> before you are ready
- ✓ ATIS has been copied
- ✓ Correct SID for your aircraft type (see general briefing page 18)
- ✓ FL70 set in your altitude window (4000' for Rwy 12/30 departure)
- ✓ Squawk set, and mode C selected latest at pushback

## Pushback

There are custom pushback routes on following stands. <u>ADVISE if able to complete custom pushback</u>, when ready for startup with EKCH\_GND on 121.900.

Parking Stand(s)	Pushback route	Alternative Pushback	remarks
<i>B4,B6,B8,B10</i>	To taxiway <mark>Y</mark> facing east	To taxiway <mark>Z</mark> facing east	If unable custom pushback push to <mark>M</mark>
<i>B7,89</i>	To taxiway <mark>X</mark> facing west	To taxiway <mark>P</mark> facing south	
D1-D4+E20-E24	To taxiway <mark>S</mark> facing north	To taxiway <mark>R</mark> facing north	Always face <b>north</b> to make the turn around

#### Taxi

You can always expect to hold short of runway 12/30.

If you want to be extra prepared you can take a look at the standard taxi routes here

### **Departure restrictions**

As you are ready to line up and depart, be well aware of following items:

- ✓ You are supposed to AUTOMATICALLY contact departure when passing 1000'
- ✓ Squawk mode C is selected
